

Basic Jail & Huber Information (Read Carefully)

Arriving at Jail

- **Do not** report under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- **Do not** arrive late.
- If you do, your **Huber Law privileges can be taken away**.
- If you take medication, bring it in the **original pharmacy bottle** with the prescription label.

Failure to Report Is a Crime

- If you do not report to the Chippewa County Jail as ordered, you will be charged with a crime.
- **Less than 10 days sentence:** misdemeanor (Wis. Stat. § 946.425(1m)(a))
- **10 days or more sentence:** felony (Wis. Stat. § 946.425(1m)(b))

Huber Approval Requirements

- **Child care and self-employment must be approved in advance.**

Report Time

- Huber report time is **Sunday at 3:00 PM**, unless the court tells you otherwise.
- Missing or incorrect paperwork can **delay your release** for Huber privileges.

Family, Friends, and Communication

- Jail staff only deliver **verified emergency messages**.
- Family and friends may contact you by **mail** or you may **call them**.
- Calls are **collect and very expensive**.
 - Call **Securus at 800-844-6591** for current rates.
- All inmate calls are recorded **except calls to attorneys**.
- Mail **must have a full return address** or it will not be delivered.
