In accordance with Chapter 66.1001(4)(d) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Chippewa County Planning and Zoning Committee will hold a public hearing at 5:00 pm in Room 302 of the county courthouse on February 23, 2026. The purpose of this hearing is to receive comments regarding *Chippewa County's Comprehensive Plan 2025-2045*.

The *Chippewa County Comprehensive Plan 2025-2045* will guide the future growth and development of the County over the next 20 years as required under Wisconsin Statutes Chapter 66.1001. The plan update reflects changes in the demographics, services, economy, and land uses in the County and integrates input from various focus groups, a farmland owner survey, and other County, town, village, and city plans. The plan includes the following primary chapters:

- Utilities & Community Facilities
- Agricultural Resources & Farmland Preservation Plan
- Natural Resources
- Historical & Cultural Resources

The plan update also serves as an update to the *Chippewa County Farmland Preservation Plan*.
